



TOP 5 LAMINATOR TIPS



1. AVOID GLITTER AND LOOSE MEDIUM

Raised and loose materials can come free of the document and stick to or damage the rollers.

2. KEEP SHARP OBJECTS AND TOOLS AWAY FROM ROLLER

These implements can nick and gouge the silicone on the rollers.

3. TURN LAMINATOR OFF AFTER USE

Unless your laminator shuts down automatically, be sure to turn it off when you're done using it. This helps protect the motor and extend the life of the machine.

4. CLEAN ADHESIVE BUILD UP FROM ROLLERS

When you change the film is a good time to clean the rollers with a moist scrubbing pad. With the machine on at a low setting, have rollers running and gently scrub any adhesive from the rollers.

5. IF IN DOUBT - SEEK PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

If something does go wrong with your laminator, be sure to call in a professional. Not only will this ensure that your laminator will be properly fixed, it can help you avoid voiding the warranty.
